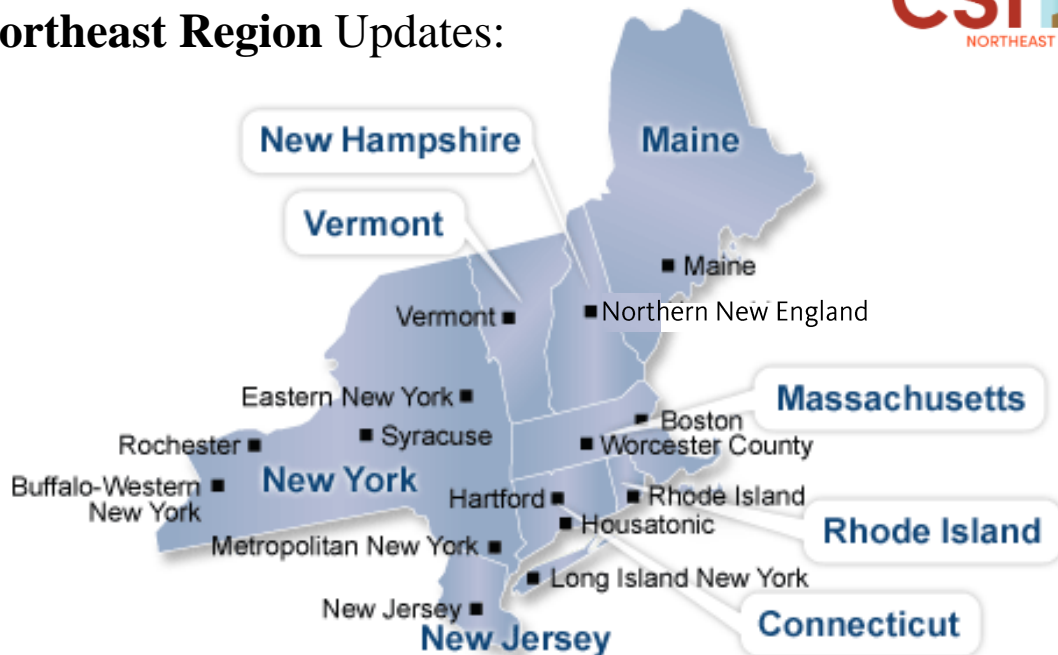
I am proud to be rejoining the Construction Specification Institute's Metro NY Chapter and looking forward to reconnecting with old friends and making new ones!

Instructors from throughout the Northeast Region have collaborated to develop an all-star “faculty” of instructors from chapters all around the Region to teach the CDT preparation classes. Each instructor holds CSI Certifications(s) of their own and is well experienced in the subject they’ll be presenting. You benefit by receiving training from the top teachers in the Region and you’ll expand your network by meeting and connecting with peers outside of your own chapter.

The Construction Documents Technology (CDT) certification provides a comprehensive program of study for anyone seeking to enhance and demonstrate knowledge of writing, interpreting, enforcing and managing construction documents. Pass the Construction Documents Technology exam (CDT), and you’ll join an elite group of professionals known in the industry for their comprehensive knowledge of the writing and management of construction documents. The only prerequisites are:

- Have a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Two (2) years’ CM experience and/or completion of college-level coursework is highly recommended.

Classes are just \$100 for any member of CSI (just 10 bucks a class!), and only \$200 for non-members. Any non-member who joins any of the 14 chapters in the Northeast Region before the last class will be reimbursed the \$100 class fee.

CSI is offering the exam itself between May 6, 2025 and June 4, 2025 so the prep classes will wrap up just as the exam window opens, so the knowledge will be fresh in your mind.
