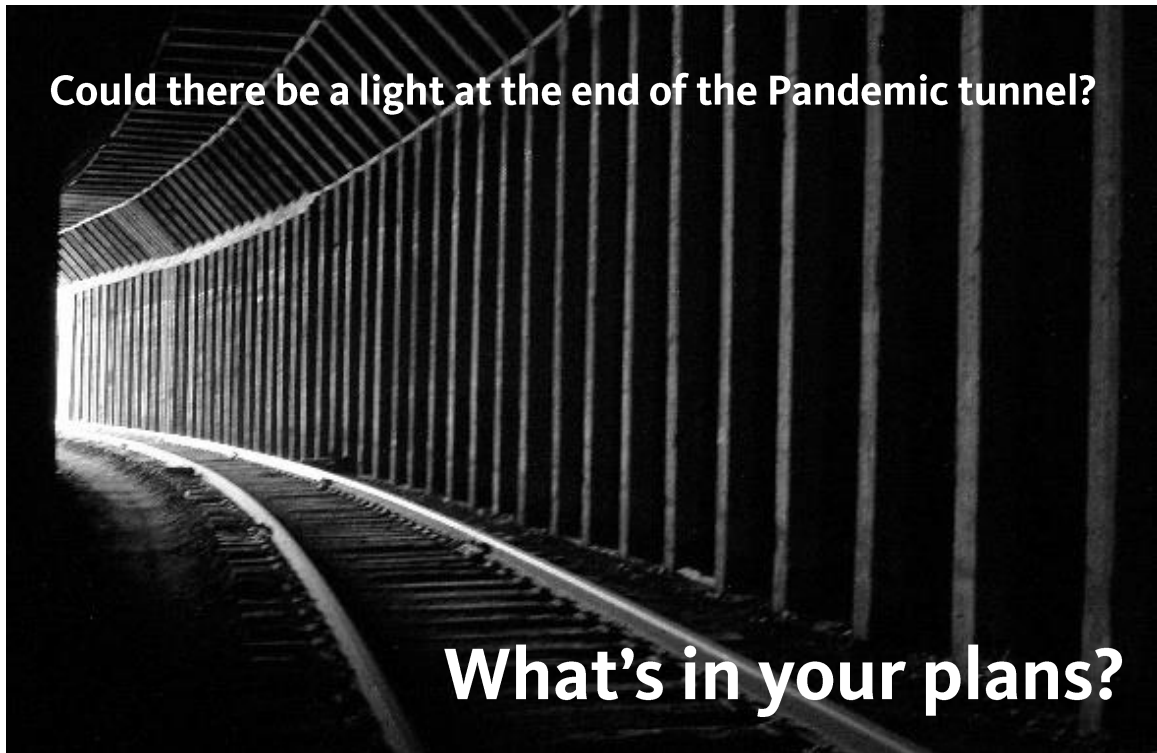

the importance of Memorial Day



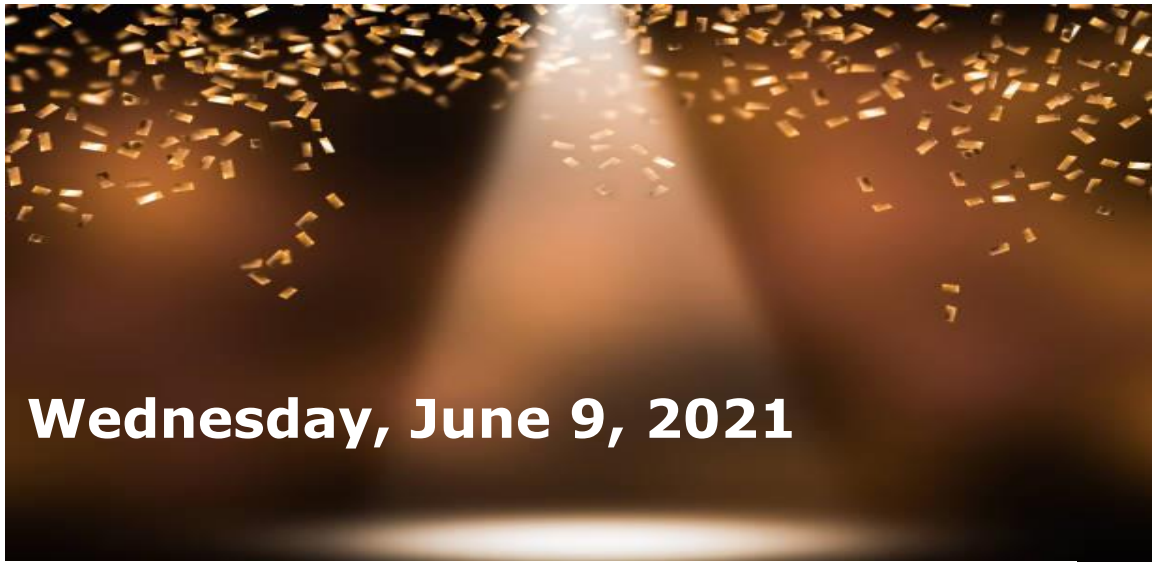

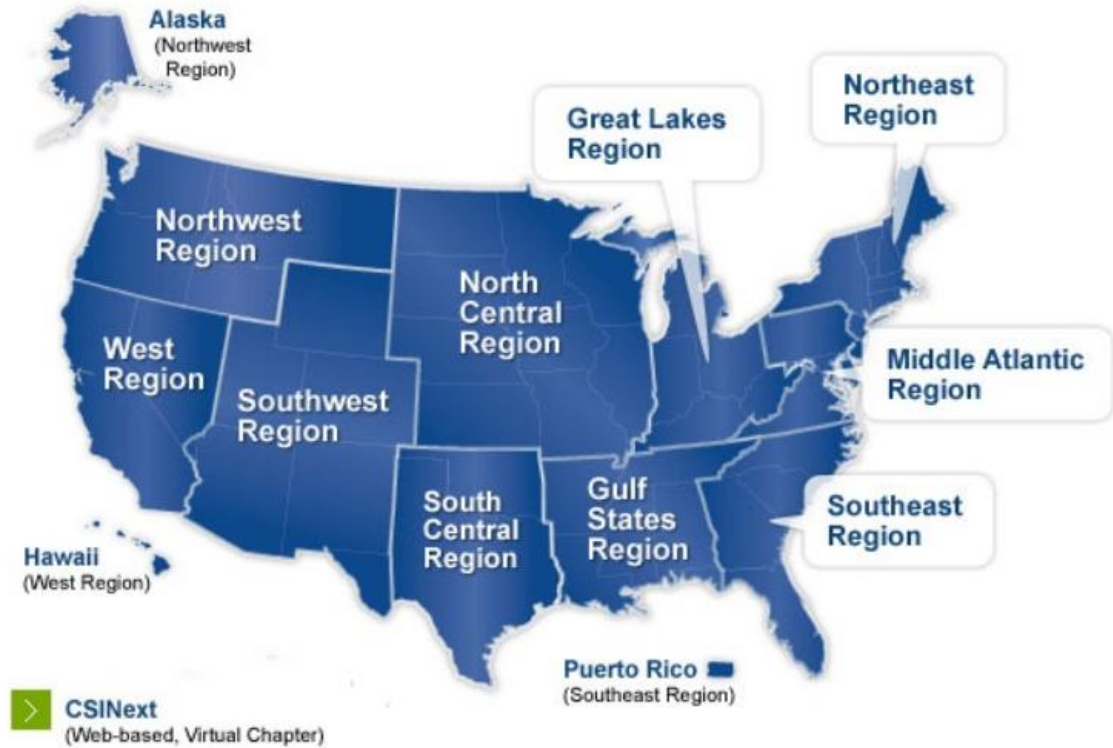
